Building services not websites

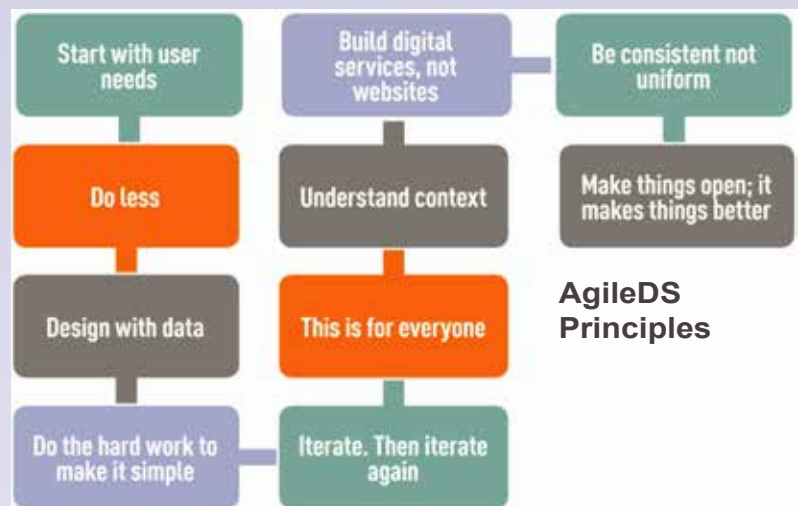
